## CONCEPT NOTE


#### Abstract

The Agency for Peacebuilding (AP) and the European Peacebuilding Liaison Office (EPLO) are co-organising a Civil Society Dialogue Network (CSDN) NGO Round-table Meeting (RTM) on the EU and peacebuilding on Tuesday 3 May in Bologna, Italy.


## Objective

The overall objective of this CSDN NGO RTM is to enable representatives of Italian-based NGOs to increase their knowledge of EU peacebuilding policies and practices, and learn about NGO advocacy on them. More specifically, it will provide them with:

- information about key peacebuilding actors in the EU institutions
- information about recent policy developments related to peacebuilding and conflict prevention at the EU level
- practical advice for engaging in advocacy on peacebuilding towards the EU


## Methodology

The NGO RTM will consist of a series of presentations by members of the EPLO office team and (possibly) a representative of an EPLO member organisation followed by interactive discussions with participants.

The NGO RTM is open to representatives from Italian-based NGOs.
